Request for Information

Question #10 of the application:

Language such as “50-mile radius of Clarion County” is unacceptable and insufficiently specific. The description of the authority needs to have clear boundaries usually requested by county/counties only, keeping with the Commission’s criteria in mind. Revise your territory request to indicate only the area from which county(s) you intend to originate service. The request should be to provide transportation from those specific county(s), to points in Pennsylvania, and return. Revise your territory or advise the below example is now what you intend.

Example:

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in Group and Party service, in vehicles seating between 11 and 15 passengers, including the driver, from points in Armstrong, Butler, Clarion, Forest, Jefferson, and Venango Counties, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.
