
On September 25, 2025, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL Electric) filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) a Petition for Modification to PPL Electric's existing Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan (Modified LTIIIP). 52 Pa. Code § 121.5(a) provides that all parties have 30 days to file comments to the Modified LTIIIP. The 30-day comment period for the Modified LTIIIP expires October 27, 2025.

On October 21, 2025, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Comments (Motion) with the Commission at the above referenced docket number. The Motion, *inter alia*, averred that the scope, size, and complexity of Modified LTIIIP, which nearly doubled the anticipated LTIIIP investment amount by December 31, 2027, required significant review beyond the amount that can be provided in 30 days. OCA also noted that it has retained an outside expert to provide assistance and guidance in preparation of its comments. As such, the OCA requested a 30-day extension of time to file comments to the Modified LTIIIP, which would be due on or before 4:30 p.m. on November 26, 2025. OCA averred in the Motion that it conferred with PPL Electric, and that PPL Electric indicated that it did not oppose a 30-day extension of the comment period.

The OCA in its Motion noted that under 52 Pa. Code Section 1.15(a)(1), whenever "an act is required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time, the time fixed or the period of time prescribed may, by the Commission, the presiding officer or other authorized person, for good cause be extended upon motion made before expiration of the period originally prescribed or as previously extended." 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(a)(1). Considering that the OCA's Motion was filed prior to the expiration of the initial comment period and that the request for an extension appears unopposed, the OCA's Motion is granted and the deadline for filing of all parties' comments to the Modified LTIIIP is hereby extended from October 27, 2025, to November 26, 2025.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition for reconsideration of staff action with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
