To Whom It May Concern,

On October 22, 2025, the Commission received William Spinapont's request to cancel a certificate of public convenience. However, William Spinapont still owes its outstanding assessment in the amount of \$34.00.

Section 510 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 510, authorizes the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to assess all public utilities a percentage of their gross intrastate operating revenues for the preceding calendar year. The Commission sent William Spinapont Notice of Assessment for fiscal year 2025/2026 on or around September 5, 2025.

The Notice of Assessment advised William Spinapont that it had thirty (30) days to pay the amount assessed. William Spinapont was further advised that if it had any objections to the assessed amount that objections had to be made in writing within fifteen (15) days and submit payment for the assessed amount.

William Spinapont did not file objections to the assessed amount and it has not submitted payment for the assessed amount.

The Commission will cancel William Spinapont's certificate of public convenience within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. Furthermore, if William Spinapont's outstanding assessment is not paid within twenty (20) days of this letter, the Commission will refer this matter to the Attorney General of Pennsylvania for appropriate action and request suspension or revocation of automobile registration with the Department of Transportation.
