I write to respectfully and formally request that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and the administrative law judges assigned to this rate case hold a Community Input Hearing in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, regarding the potential PPL rate increases currently proposed for PPL users. I represent PA State House District 96, which is the site of two future data centers - one is currently under construction, and one will begin construction in 2027/28. Our residents would appreciate being heard regarding the rate increases currently proposed by PPL, particularly because we face possible rate increases in the future associated with the development of the two local data centers. In addition, the education about rates, in general, will be of great value to our residents. Commissioner Barrow's statements regarding cost allocation and universal service, support the need to have a Community Input Hearing in Lancaster.

Please consider hosting a Community Input Hearing in HD96 in the near future. We have facilities that could possibly serve as the venue for such an event - J.P. McCaskey High School (ample free parking), Manheim Township High School (ample free parking), The Ware Center (although parking will be more of a challenge/barrier for attendees), and possibly some other locations. I'm sure we can come up with something suitable for the event and I'm sure that the event will be well attended.
