Dear Mr. Lent:

By Order entered September 11, 2025, the Commission authorized UGI Utilities, Inc. - Gas Division (the Company) to file a tariff supplement in the form set forth in Appendix A to the Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement of All Issues filed in the above docketed rate investigation, designed to produce a net increase in annual distribution operating revenues of \$69.5 million. On October 27, 2025, the Company filed Supplement No. 59 to UGI Gas – Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 and 7S to become effective October 28, 2025 in compliance with the Order. The Company also included detailed proof of revenue calculations to demonstrate that the rates contained in the tariff supplement comply with the Order.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 59 to UGI Gas – Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 and 7S is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
