Electric Generation Supplier License Cancellations of  
Companies with an Expired Financial Security

**FINAL ORDER**

On August 28, 2025, a Tentative Order was entered in the above captioned proceeding.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.42(a) require that a licensee shall comply with the applicable requirements of the code and Commission regulations and orders. Consistent with due process, a license may be suspended or revoked, and fines may be imposed against the licensee for failure to furnish and maintain a bond or other security approved by the Commission in the amount directed by the Commission.

The Electric Generation Suppliers (EGS) listed in Table 1 below filed approved financial security within 30 days after publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.
