RE: Electric Generation Supplier License Application

Dear Mr. Doueck:

On July 18, 2025, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) received AEC Energy LLC dba AEC Energy Management (AEC Energy) Application for an Electric Generation Supplier (EGS) license. On August 14, 2025, the Commission notified AEC Energy through a Secretarial Letter that its EGS license Application was not properly completed and contained deficiencies that must be corrected and submitted within 20 days. The Secretarial Letter stated that failure to timely respond would result in the Application being deemed rejected¹ and the docket closed. To date, a corrected and complete Application has not been received by the Commission's Secretary's Bureau.

Given AEC Energy's failure to correct the deficiencies and provide a complete EGS license Application, the Commission deems AEC Energy's EGS license Application unacceptable and therefore it is rejected without prejudice. The Application fee is a processing fee and NOT refundable.

Please be advised that if AEC Energy were to resubmit an Application for an EGS license, it must file a complete EGS license Application and submit a filing fee of \$350.
