INTERIM ORDER

On October 9, 2025, a Prehearing Conference Order was entered requiring the filing of prehearing memoranda by November 14, 2025, and scheduling a prehearing conference for November 19, 2025.

On October 24, 2025, counsel provided an email to the undersigned presiding officers advising that the parties (PAWC, Sutersville-Sewickley Municipal Sewage Authority, and OSBA) (the Parties) have been engaged in settlement discussions and have reached a settlement in principle. Accordingly, the Parties requested that no litigation schedule be set at this time, and that the Parties instead be permitted to work on preparing a Joint Petition for Settlement as well as Joint Stipulation of Fact.

The Parties further requested that the prehearing conference currently scheduled for November 19, 2025, be converted to a status conference and that the Parties be permitted to forego submitting prehearing memoranda. The Parties also advised that a Petition to Intervene was filed by Sutersville-Sewickley Municipal Sewage Authority.

On October 29, 2025, the Parties provided an email to the undersigned presiding officers advising that no Party or Intervenor has an objection to the Petition to Intervene filed by Sutersville-Sewickley Municipal Sewage Authority and that all Parties consent to converting the prehearing conference into a status conference.

Under the circumstances, the following Interim Order will be entered.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Petition to Intervene filed by Sutersville-Sewickley Municipal Sewage Authority on August 22, 2025, is hereby granted, without objection by any Party.
2. That the prehearing conference currently scheduled for November 19, 2025, is hereby converted to a status conference. No further Notice will be provided in addition to this Order.
3. That the Parties are hereby excused from the filing or submission of prehearing memoranda.

4. That any other issues addressed in the Prehearing Conference Order entered on October 9, 2025, including the filing of any additional petitions to intervene or protests, may be raised at the Status Conference on November 19, 2025.
