Employed by Westmoreland County Community Action from 2021 to 2023 as a Mental Health Housing Case Manager/Coach. This job required daily travel using agency-owned passenger vans and personally owned vehicles. Common transportation tasks included: Transporting individual clients and their minor children to grocery stores, medical appointments, legal proceedings, etc. This position required discipline, empathy, communication skills, schedule adherence, and planning, to name a few. Maintained a zero incident/accident record throughout employment tenure.

Retired military servicemember with 25 years of experience operating various government-owned vehicles. Operated various types of military vehicles transporting passengers and supplies to various destinations, in multiple states and countries. This includes vehicle operation (with passengers and supplies) in Kuwait and Iraq respectively. Operated vehicles in all weather conditions. While serving in recruiting command, I obtained nearly 14 years of almost-daily experience operating 14 passenger vans and smaller vehicles to transport future soldiers, applicants, and other people for the purpose of military entrance processing. These trips commonly crossed multiple county (and sometimes) state boundary lines. All trips required pre and post vehicle inspections. Gained experience as fleet manager charged with the management of 5 government vehicles attached to the recruiting station/center. This duty required daily tasks to include, log book management, maintenance scheduling/recording, driver assignments, etc. Maintained a zero loss/incident/accident report throughout my entire military career.
