REPRESENTATION. If you are an individual, you may represent yourself or you may have an attorney represent you. **All others, including a partnership, corporation, limited liability company, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania, or admitted pro hac vice. Only an attorney may represent someone else.**

FAILURE TO APPEAR. Please arrive by 8:45 A.M. for your scheduled hearing. You may lose the case if you do not take part in this hearing and present evidence on the issue(s) raised.

CONTINUANCES. You may request a continuance of the hearing if you have a good reason. All continuances will be granted only for good cause. To request a continuance, you must submit a written request (a “motion”) at least five (5) days before the hearing. Your motion should include: (1) The case name, number, and hearing date; (2) The reason for the request; and (3) Whether the other party agrees (or if you do not know).

PRESENTING EXHIBITS. If you intend to present any documents or exhibits at the hearing, you must email one (1) copy to the Presiding Officer at efarren@pa.gov and one (1) copy each must be sent to every other party. All copies must be received at least five (5) business days before the hearing. Proposed exhibits should be properly pre-marked for identification purposes.

ACCOMMODATION. Any party who needs an accommodation for a disability in order to participate in this hearing process may request one. Please call the scheduling office at least five (5) business days prior to your hearing to submit your request.

If you require an interpreter to participate in the hearing, please call the scheduling office at least ten (10) business days prior to your hearing to submit your request.

DOCUMENTS. All Parties to proceedings pending are encouraged to either open and use an e-Filing account through the Commission’s website at www.puc.pa.gov or to ensure timely arrival, submit the filing by overnight delivery as explained below.

This service allows a user to file documents electronically and receive an automatic email notification whenever a document is added, removed, or changed on the Commission website in a specific case. confidential or proprietary material may also be submitted through the Commission's Share Point File system. These filings should be followed by a hard copy for the Commission's file. Filers should contact the Secretary's Bureau in advance to set up a Share Point File before submitting the filing.
