PREHEARING MEMORANDUM SUBMITTED BY DIMENSION PA 1 LLC

This Prehearing Memorandum is submitted on behalf of Proposed Intervenor Dimension PA 1 LLC (Dimension”) with respect to the Conference now scheduled for November 5, 2025.

1. Proposed Plan and Schedule for discovery. Interested parties should be allowed to propound one set of Interrogatories, a Notice to Produce and Requests for Admissions upon any other interested party by November 12, 2025 to be answered within 30 days. Requests for Admissions that are not denied will be deemed admitted. After discovery is received, further sets of Interrogatories may be propounded. For good cause shown, in limited circumstances, depositions can be taken.
2. Possibility of Settlement. While Dimension favors a negotiated resolution that is fair to all parties, settlement talks are premature at this time.
3. Issues: Dimension reserves the right to further scrutinize the record and further identify all issues that exist. However, at this time, the issues include the appropriateness of the new peak load concept put forward, specifically its cost basis and whether it is discriminatory to customer generators. Investigation through discovery may also identify additional issues.

4. Amount of Hearing Time needed. Dimension cannot address this in an informed manner until discovery is obtained.
5. Witnesses. Dimension has not yet determined if it will be presenting witnesses at this hearing, but reserves the right to do so. If witnesses will be presented, Dimension will notify the Court and counsel in a timely manner prior to the hearing.
6. Schedule for submission of testimony, hearings, and briefs. We are generally in agreement with the proposed schedule of the Court. Reasonable and limited departures from the Court's schedule would not be objectionable.
7. Public Input hearings. No Position.
8. Any other appropriate matter. None at this time.
