

**STATUS REPORT**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”) submits the following Status Report to Administrative Law Judge Katrina L. Dunderdale (the “ALJ”). Duquesne Light has been authorized to present this Status Report on its behalf as well as on behalf of Clovernote Holdings, LLC (“Clovernote”) and Hudson Energy Services, LLC (“Hudson”) (collectively, the “Parties”).

**I. Introduction**

On May 9, 2025, the Parties participated in a Prehearing Conference presided over by Special Agent Michael Mroczka (“Special Agent”). At the Prehearing Conference, the Parties agreed to suspend the litigation schedule in this matter to gather information and discuss settlement. Also on May 9, 2025, the Special Agent issued an Interim Order Suspending Litigation Schedule, which suspended the litigation schedule and required the Parties to file monthly status reports on the last business day of every month, until this matter is resolved by settlement, or a hearing or prehearing conference is requested. On May 30, July 1, July 31, August 29, and October

1, 2025, the Parties submitted status reports. On October 22, 2025, the Commission issued a Judge Change Notice, reassigning this case to the ALJ.


## **II. Status Report**
