17. Customers.

- a. State the seller’s actual number of customers by class and quantify the related consumption or gallons treated in the current calendar year and future number of connections anticipated for the next 5 years and if available, the next 10 years.

**RESPONSE:** a. As of June 30, 2025, ICVWA furnished water service to 2,389 customers, including the following bulk customers:

1. Pleasant Valley Water Authority (2 bulk connections)
2. PAWC

ICVWA customers by class: 2,150 residential, 203 commercial, 1 industrial, 3 bulk, 7 public fire and 25 other.

**Consumption (annual):**

Based on ICVWA’s 2024 Annual Report, the annual total consumption was 117,930,800 gallons.

Based on conversations with the Authority there are many unconnected customers proximate to ICVWA mains that currently do not want to pay ICVWA’s tap fee (a mandatory tap-in ordinance does not exist). PAWC does not have a tap fee, so many of these customers may want to connect once the system is acquired. The projections below are based on discussions with the Authority.
