VERIFICATION


I David Cramer, Chairman, on behalf of Seller, Indian Creek Valley Water Authority (“ICVWA”) in connection with the foregoing Application, hereby state the following:

1. Notice of the ICVWA public meetings identified in Paragraph 2 below was provided pursuant to the Pennsylvania Sunshine Act, 65 Pa.C.S.A. § 709 in the Daily Courier on March 17, 2025, and March 24, 2025, which is a newspaper of general circulation within ICVWA’s service territory.
2. Prior to executing the APA, ICVWA held the following two public meetings to address, evaluate and approve the Transaction: March 27, 2025 (3:00-4:30 PM) and March 27, 2025 (5:00-6:30 PM).
3. At the March 27 meetings, information was provided and questions were received and answered, including, among other things, explanation of the potential rate impact of a water system sale and the PUC’s jurisdiction over future rate increase requests.
4. The public meetings provided an opportunity for public comment both orally to one or more representative(s) of ICVWA and in the form of written comment submissions.
5. Approximately forty (40) members of the public attended and signed-in or offered comment at the public meeting in Saltlick Township. Approximately eighteen (18) members of the public attended and signed-in or offered comment at the public meeting in Springfield Township. ICVWA received written public comment submissions from three (3) individuals at the Saltlick Township public meeting. ICVWA received written public comment submissions from four (4) individuals at the Springfield Township meeting.

6. The public meetings were held at venues within the municipal boundaries of the Seller at the following locations in Saltlick and Springfield Townships:
 - a. Saltlick Township Municipal Building, 147 Municipal Bldg Rd, Melcroft, PA 15462 (3:00-4:30 PM on March 27, 2025)
 - b. Normalville Volunteer Fire Hall, 3387 Springfield Pike, Normalville, PA 15469 (5:00-6:30 PM on March 27, 2025)
