To Whom It May Concern:

On 7/2/2025 the application of A AA Medical Transport Inc. was received by the Commission and presented for review. Upon full consideration of the information provided in the initial application, the subsequent answer to our data request, and the applicant's sworn statement through the assessment process, where they report no jurisdictional revenue, it has been determined that the proposed operations of A AA Medical Transport Inc. are not under the Jurisdiction of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

A AA Medical Transport Inc.'s expansion services will be identical to existing services. As such, the requested transportation services remain outside of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's jurisdiction and are exempt from Commission regulation and oversight.

APPEAL RIGHTS

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission are advised to open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by mail. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by mail.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. *See* 52 Pa. Code §§1.31 and 5.44. Below is a sample Verification:
