Receipt is acknowledged of the Application of eNetworks, LLC, (Applicant) for approval to offer, render, furnish, or supply telecommunications services to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a Competitive Access Provider (CAP) (statewide). The Application has been reviewed and found to be in compliance with the Commission's filing requirements as set out in *Re: Implementation of the Telecommunications Act of 1996*, Docket No. M-00960799 (*Implementation Order*: June 3, 1996; and *Implementation Reconsideration Order*: September 9, 1996) (*Implementation Orders*).

Pursuant to the *Implementation Orders*, the Applicant now has provisional authority to provide CAP services in Pennsylvania. However, this provisional authority may be revoked if, upon further Commission review, the Application is found to contain additional deficiencies.

Please note provisional authority is only being granted for telecommunications services that are under the jurisdiction of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.
