ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

We adopt as our action the Recommended Decision of Administrative Law
Judge John M. Coogan dated October 3, 2025;

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Joint Petition for Settlement filed September 9, 2025, by the City of Lock Haven Water Department and the Office of Consumer Advocate at Docket No. P-2024-3050183 is granted, and the Settlement is approved in its entirety without modification.

2. That Lock Haven's Lead Service Line Replacement Plan is withdrawn, consistent with the Joint Petition for Settlement.

3. That, within thirty (30) days of the entry of the Commission's Final Order, Lock Haven is directed to file an updated lead service line inventory which reflects that no lead service lines have been identified in the City's Commission jurisdictional area. This filing must include a verified statement and identification of the number of lead service lines currently remaining in non-Commission jurisdictional areas of the City, consistent with the Joint Petition for Settlement. A copy of the filing must be served upon the Bureau of Technical Utility Services and all active parties in this proceeding.

4. That Lock Haven is directed to file a Petition for Approval of a Lead Service Line Replacement Program with the Commission within ninety (90) days if the City discovers a lead service line in its Commission jurisdictional areas.
