Your payment is an admission that you committed the alleged violations and an agreement to cease and desist from committing further violations. Upon receipt of your payment, the Complaint proceeding shall be closed.

D. If you file an Answer, which either admits or fails to deny the allegations of the Complaint, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement will request the Commission to issue an Order imposing the administrative penalty and granting the requested relief as set forth in the Complaint.

E. If you file an Answer which contests the Complaint, the matter will proceed before the assigned presiding Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. The Judge is not bound by the penalty set forth in the Complaint and may impose additional and/or alternative penalties as appropriate.

F. If you are a corporation, you must be represented by legal counsel. 52 Pa. Code § 1.21.

FORMAL COMPLAINT

NOW COMES the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, by its prosecuting attorneys, pursuant to Section 182 of the Underground Utility Line Protection Law (“UULPL” or “PA One Call Law”), Act of October 29, 2024, P.L. 1106, No. 127, 73 P.S. § 182.8(c)(2), and files this Formal Complaint (“Complaint”) against Eddystone Borough (“Eddystone,” “the Borough,” or “Respondent”) alleging violations of the PA One Call Law in connection with a strike on a 2-inch gas service line operated by PECO Energy Company – Gas (“PECO”) in the vicinity of 1248 E. 12th Street, Eddystone Borough, Delaware County, Pennsylvania. In support of its Complaint, I&E respectfully avers as follows:

I. COMMISSION JURISDICTION AND AUTHORITY

1. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “PUC”), with a mailing address of the Commonwealth Keystone Building, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate, *inter alia*, municipalities, within the Commonwealth pursuant to the PA One Call Law, Act of October 29, 2024, P.L. 1106, No. 127, 73 P.S. §§ 176 *et seq.*

2. Complainant is the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, which is the bureau established to take enforcement actions against public utilities and other entities subject to the Commission’s jurisdiction pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 308.2(a)(11). *See also Implementation of Act 129 of 2008; Organization of Bureaus and Offices*, Docket No. M-2008-2071852 (August 11, 2011) (delegating authority to initiate proceedings that are prosecutory in nature to I&E).

4. Respondent is Eddystone Borough, with a main mailing address of 225 3rd Street, Eddystone, PA 15419.

5. Eddystone Borough meets the definition of a “facility owner” pursuant to Section 176 of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 176.¹

6. Section 177 of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 177, imposes duties on facility owners.

7. Specifically, Section 177(5)(vii) of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 177(5)(vii), requires facility owners to “respond to emergency notifications as soon as practicable following

¹ “Facility owner” is defined as the public utility or agency, political subdivision, **municipality**, authority, rural electric cooperative or other person or entity who or which owns or operates a line.” 73 P.S. § 176. (emphasis added). A “line” or “facility” is defined as “an underground pipe used in . . . sewage, water or other service to one or more . . . consumers or customers of such service and the appurtenances thereto, regardless of whether such line or structure is located on land owned by a person or public agency or whether it is located within an easement or right-of-way.” 73 P.S. § 176.

receipt of notification of such emergency. The response by the facility owner shall be consistent with the nature of the emergency information received by the facility owner”

73 P.S. § 177(5)(vii).

8. Respondent, as a facility owner, is subject to the power and authority of this Commission pursuant to Section 182.10 of the PA One Call Law, which requires facility owners to comply with the PA One Call Law. 73 P.S. § 182.10.

9. An “emergency” is defined in the PA One Call Law as “a sudden or unforeseen occurrence involving a clear and immediate danger to life, property or the environment, including, but not limited to, serious breaks or defects in a facility owner's lines.” 73 P.S. § 176.

10. Section 182.8(c)-(d) and Section 182.10 of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. §§ 182.8(c)-(d) and 182.10, authorize the Commission to, *inter alia*, hear and determine complaints against excavators for violations of the PA One Call Law and to enforce the provisions of the PA One Call Law. 73 P.S. §§ 182.8(c)-(d) and 182.10.

11. Section 182.8(c)(2) of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 182.8(c)(2), authorizes the Commission’s prosecutorial staff to bring a formal complaint against entities subject to the PA One Call Law. 73 P.S. § 182.8(c)(2).

12. Section 182.10 of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 182.10(b)(1)(i)-(ii), authorizes the Commission to impose administrative penalties on any person or corporation, subject to the PA One Call Law, who violates any provisions of the PA One Call Law or any regulation or order issued thereunder governing underground utility lines, of up to \$2,500 per violation or if the violation results in injury, death, or property damage of \$25,000 dollars or more an administrative penalty not to exceed \$50,000. 73 P.S. § 182.10(b)(1)(i)-(ii).

13. Pursuant to the provisions of the applicable Commonwealth statutes and regulations, the Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this Complaint and the actions of Respondent related thereto.

II. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

14. On November 8, 2024, McClain Brothers Plumbing was excavating with a backhoe in the vicinity of 1248 E. 12th Street, Eddystone Borough, to make repairs to a sanitary sewer when it struck and damaged a correctly marked 2-inch plastic gas main. I&E Exhibit 1.

15. After striking the line, McClain Brothers Plumbing alerted emergency services in accordance with the PA One Call Law, and police were dispatched to the scene. I&E Exhibit 2.

16. McClain Brothers Plumbing was excavating pursuant to a New Excavation Emergency Ticket, serial number 20243113295 (“Excavation Emergency Ticket”). I&E Exhibit 3.

17. The stated reason for the emergency excavation was a “sidewalk sticking up due to tree roots.” Id.

18. The Excavation Emergency Ticket was submitted to the Pennsylvania One Call System (“POCS”) by McClain Brothers Plumbing on November 6, 2024, with excavation scheduled to start on November 8, 2024, and a response due date for facility owners to provide a response to the Excavation Emergency Ticket by November 7, 2024. Id.

19. Respondent received notification of the Excavation Emergency Ticket on November 6, 2024, at 3:03 PM. Id.

20. However, Respondent failed to respond to the Excavation Emergency Ticket, and a response of “NO RESPONSE” was automatically input for Respondent by POCS on November 8, 2024, at 12:01 AM.

21. After striking the 2-inch gas main operated by PECO, McClain Brothers Plumbing submitted a New Damage Emergency Ticket, serial number 20243131163 (“Damage Emergency Ticket”). I&E Exhibit 4.

22. The Damage Emergency Ticket was submitted on November 8, 2024, and requested a response by the same day. Id.

23. Respondent received notification of the Damage Emergency Ticket through POCS on November 8, 2024, at 10:47 AM. Id.

24. However, Respondent failed to respond to the Damage Emergency Ticket.

25. As a result of its failure to provide a response through POCS to the Damage Emergency Ticket, a response of “NO RESPONSE” was automatically input at 12:48 PM on November 8, 2024. Id.

26. Although this incident involved an excavator striking a gas service line,² Eddystone Borough, as a facility owner, was required to provide a response “as soon as practicable following receipt of notification of the emergency by the One Call System.”

27. Its response should have been consistent with the nature of the emergency information received — in this case, a gas line strike.

28. On March 24, 2025, a copy of the report prepared by the Damage Prevention Investigator (“DPI”) from the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, Damage Prevention Section, was mailed to Eddystone Borough informing Respondent that it was in violation of the PA One Call Law by failing to respond an emergency notification as soon as practicable following notification. The letter further informed Respondent that it could either

accept the findings in the DPI's report or reject them and present its case to the Damage Prevention Committee ("DPC").

29. On April 22, 2025, Eddystone Borough rejected the finding of the DPI's report and requested to present its case via email.

30. On May 15, 2025, a notification of the DPC meeting was mailed to Eddystone, informing Respondent that it could present its case for discussion at the June 10, 2025, DPC meeting.

31. Respondent did not attend the DPC meeting. Its case was nevertheless discussed and voted upon by the DPC.

32. On June 11, 2025, a copy of the DPC's Informal Determination accepting the DPI's report and proposed penalty was mailed to Eddystone Borough, informing Respondent that it could either accept the DPC's Informal Determination or reject it in writing within thirty (30) days of the date of the notification letter, and that if the Informal Determination is rejected the case may be sent to I&E prosecutory staff for issuance of a formal complaint.

33. On July 8, 2025, Eddystone Borough rejected the DPC's informal determination via an email to the DPI.

III. VIOLATIONS

34. Paragraphs 1-33 are incorporated herein as if stated in their entirety.

Counts 1-2

35. Respondent failed to respond to an emergency notification as soon as practicable following notification.

If proven, this is a violation of Section 177(5)(vii) of the PA One Call Law, 73 P.S. § 177(5)(vii) (2 counts). As a facility owner, Respondent was obligated to respond to the emergency notification “as soon as practicable” following notification of the emergency tickets.

In this case, the Excavation Emergency Ticket specified November 7, 2024, at as the due date for a response. The Damage Emergency Ticket specified November 8, 2024, as the due date for a response. Both tickets show that Respondent was properly notified. However, the Respondent did not provide any response to either emergency ticket and was marked as having provided “NO RESPONSE” by POCS.

Although this incident involved an excavator striking a gas service line, Eddystone Borough, as a facility owner, was required to provide a response “as soon as practicable following receipt of notification of the emergency by the One Call System.” Facility owners such as Respondent must respond expeditiously to emergency tickets submitted by excavators so that they may proceed with their emergency repairs to sewer, water, electric, and gas lines across the Commonwealth.

The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement’s proposed cumulative administrative penalty for these violations is \$2,000 (\$1,000/count).

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement respectfully requests that the Commission:

- (1) Find Eddystone Borough to be in violation of the PA One Call Law at 73 P.S. § 177(5)(vii);
- (2) Impose an administrative penalty upon Eddystone Borough in the amount of \$2,000, to be paid within 30 days of the entry of a Final Order; and

- (3) Order Eddystone Borough to attend Online Compliance Training through the Pennsylvania One Call System for facility owners and provide proof of compliance to the Commission within 30 days of the entry of a Final Commission Order; and
- (4) Order such other remedies as the Commission may deem appropriate.
- (5) If payment of the administrative penalty is not made as set forth, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement requests that this matter be referred to the Pennsylvania Office of the Attorney General for appropriate action.
