Re: Petition of FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company for Approval of Smart Meter Technology Procurement and Installation Plan; Change in Smart Meter Technologies Charge Rider Rates

Dear Ms. Savage:

On July 31, 2025, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (FE PA) filed proposed Smart Meter Technologies Charge (SMT-C) rates to become effective January 1, 2026. The annual filing reflects changes in the SMT-C rates for the Residential, Commercial, and Industrial customer classes pursuant to the Commission's Order at Docket No. M-2009-2123950 entered June 9, 2010 for the Met-Ed, Penelec, and Penn Power Rate Districts, and the Commission's Order at Docket No. M-2009-2123951 entered June 30, 2011 for the West Penn Rate District. FE PA filed pro-forma revisions to Tariff Electric - Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 illustrating the proposed SMT-C rates for each Rate District, along with supporting calculations.¹


Commission Staff has reviewed the proposed SMT-C rates and pro-forma tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, the proposed SMT-C rates for the Residential, Commercial, and Industrial customer classes are approved to become effective January 1, 2026. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.

The Commission directs FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company to submit a tariff compliance filing to reflect the proposed changes in the SMT-C rates effective on at least one day's notice.

¹ Per Opinion and Order entered on November 21, 2024 at Docket No. R-2024-3047068, SMT-C rates are collected in FE PA's base rates effective January 1, 2025. Accordingly, the proposed SMT-C rates and pro forma tariff revisions to Tariff Electric - Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 reflect only the return or collection of prior period over/(under) collections.
