RE: Application of Mainlines, Manholes & Wastewater Treatment, Inc. for approval, *nunc pro tunc*, of the right to begin to offer, render, furnish, and supply wastewater service to the public in portions of Girard and Waterford Townships, Erie County, Pennsylvania at Docket No. A-2024-3050786

Dear Attorneys Snyder and Rosengarten:

On August 16, 2024, Mainlines, Manholes & Wastewater Treatment, Inc. (Mainlines) filed the above-captioned document (Application) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). Mainlines subsequently amended its Application on August 28, 2024, to remove its request for territory in Fairview Township and instead request territory in Waterford Township.

On September 10, 2024, the Office of Small Business Advocate (OSBA) filed a protest (Protest) to the Application. On September 13, 2024, the Commission served a Secretarial Letter containing the Bureau of Technical Utility Services (TUS) Data Request Set 1, and the Application was reassigned to the Office of Administrative Law Judge (OALJ). Subsequently, Mainlines filed partial responses to TUS Data Request Set 1, Item Nos. A-1 and A-2 on October 3, 2024.

On August 22, 2025, Mainlines filed a Joint Stipulation of Mainlines & OSBA. On September 4, 2025, OSBA filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Protest to allow the withdrawal of OSBA's Protest. On September 26, 2025, Administrative Law Judge Katrina L. Dunderdale issued an Order Transferring Application for Technical Review that reassigned the Application from OALJ to TUS.

Since Mainlines has not yet filed responses to all the data requests in TUS Data Request Set 1, this Secretarial Letter is to inform Mainlines that responses to TUS Data Request Set 1 must be filed with the Commission within ten (10) business days from the date of this letter. If Mainlines cannot provide the requested information within ten (10) business days from the date of this letter, Mainlines should file a letter to this docket requesting an extension of time and providing a date certain when Mainlines can provide the requested information. Failure to provide complete responses to TUS Data Request Set 1 may result in rejection of the Application without prejudice to refile with required information. 52 Pa. Code § 3.501(a).

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition for reconsideration of staff action with the Commission within 20 days of the date this letter is served.
