3. Give a general description of the nature and character of the services rendered by the applicant.

The Commission authorized Loop Telecom to provide Competitive Access Services pursuant to a Certificate of Public Convenience granted on September 12, 2023, in Docket No. A-2023-3039781. Loop Telecom offered such services previously but as of October 1, 2025 has no customers.

4. Provide a statement of change in service proposed by the company for which Commission approval is sought.

Pursuant to the transaction authorized by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission on September 19, 2025 (Docket Nos. A-2025-3056166 and A-2025-3056168) (the “Transaction”), Loop Telecom transferred all assets, except for its Certificate of Public Convenience, to Loop Broadband LLC (“Loop Broadband”). Loop Broadband was granted Certificate of Public Convenience authority to provide Competitive Access Services on September 11, 2025 in Docket No. A-2025-3056051. The Commission recognized in its authorization order that Loop Telecom may seek cancellation of its Certificate of Public Convenience authority once the Transaction was complete.

As confirmed by the October 6, 2025 notice provided to the Commission, the Transaction was completed on October 1, 2025. Accordingly, Loop Telecom no longer provides services.

5. Provide a summary of the revenue derived from the operation of the service sought to be discontinued, together with a statement of the expenses accruing from the maintenance of that service. This information may be furnished in detail and attached to the application.

Following the completion of the Transaction, Loop Telecom does not provide or offer any services and has no revenues.

6. Approval of the application is necessary or proper for the following reasons:

Loop Telecom no longer utilizes its Certificate of Public Convenience to provide Competitive Access Services.

7. Provide a detailed explanation of why the company wishes to abandon its certificate.

As Loop Telecom has transferred all assets to Loop Broadband and no longer offers services, it respectfully requests that the Commission cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience for Competitive Access Services and withdraw its Competitive Access Tariff.

8. Provide the number of customers served and date last served.

Loop Telecom ceased the offering of telecommunications services as of September 30, 2025. At all times Loop Telecom served fewer than 100 customers.

9. What happened to these customers? Who is serving them now?

All of Loop Telecom's assets and business (other than its license) were transferred on October 1, 2025 to Loop Broadband.
