Request for Information

- 1) Your original application was made in 2005. It is now 2025, and the environment in which we live is very different from those earlier times. Regulations require responses that reflect the requirements of Paratransit Authority. Your responses to questions 5(a), 5(b), 5(c), 5(d) and 5(e) of the verified statements are insufficient. Title 52 Pa. Code § 29 provides detailed requirements. **Please provide a system which incorporates code specified compliance requirements for frequency and retention of driving records. Regardless of who the drivers may be, the system must be in place and you must provide answers to these questions. Google the 52 PA Code, and you will find them there.** Your answers to sections regarding the below were insufficient:
 - § 29.503. Age restrictions.
 - § 29.504. Driver history
 - § 29.505. Criminal history.
- 2) A vehicle list is required, and you have omitted the VIN Numbers. Please submit you're your answer.
- 3) Please fully state your vehicle safety program, a reference to having a system is not sufficient. Passenger safety is of utmost importance.
- 4) Your statement of financial position does not show that you have enough funds to pay for your insurance premiums. How do you intend to do so? The business must be adequately funded to be certificated.

Your previous authority was cancelled for failure to provide proof of insurance. Regardless of the circumstances which led to that happening, you must provide evidence of financial fitness in order to have the authority granted again.
