Dear Chairman DeFrank:

As the cost of living continues to rise across the region, many residents are feeling the strain on their household budgets. In Lancaster County, this strain is being compounded by increasing utility costs. This September, the City of Lancaster announced a plan to increase its water rates. An additional burden at a time when consumers are already facing higher prices for housing, groceries, and energy. I am deeply concerned about the impact these rising costs will have on local families and individuals who are already struggling to make ends meet.

As you know, the City's Bureau of Water does not just provide water to City residents. Many of the communities I represent in the 36th Senate District are served by the City of Lancaster Bureau of Water and have contacted my office to share their concerns about rising prices.

I am increasingly worried about the effects these rate raises will have on my constituents. I ask that the the Public Utility Commission scrutinize these rate raises closely. Please minimize any increases and ensure the City has pursued all possible alternative sources of funding to supplement rate increases, in whole or in part. Taking this action is a critical step in ensuring the Lancaster area remains affordable for all members of our community.
