**INTERIM ORDER
ON BRIEFING SCHEDULE**

This Interim Order memorializes the briefing schedule proposed during the Evidentiary Hearing held in this matter on November 12, 2025.

HISTORY OF PROCEEDING

On August 18, 2025, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) filed a Formal Complaint (Complaint) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) against Nyce Construction Services, Inc. (Nyce) alleging Nyce violated the Pennsylvania One Call Law, 73 P.S. §§ 180(2.1), 180(16). I&E requested the Commission impose an administrative penalty in the amount of \$3,500.

On September 8, 2025, Nyce, by and through legal counsel, filed an Answer to the Complaint denying the allegations, averring an administrative penalty is not warranted, and requesting dismissal of the Complaint.

On September 19, 2025, the Commission issued a Hearing Notice, informing the parties of an in-person Evidentiary Hearing to be held on November 12, 2025.

On September 19, 2025, I issued a Prehearing Order, setting forth the governing rules for the Evidentiary Hearing.

On November 12, 2025, the Evidentiary Hearing convened as scheduled. Counsel for I&E, Grant Rosul, Esq., appeared along with one witness, Ms. Sara Andrade-Locke, Damage Prevention Supervisor. Counsel for Nyce, Kevin T. Fogerty, Esq., appeared along with one witness, Mr. Shaun Froshour, Nyce Project Manager.

During the Evidentiary Hearing, both Parties presented issues I determined incited questions of law. To allow Parties the opportunity to fully address the legal arguments raised, I offered the Parties dates to submit legal memoranda. The Parties agreed to submit Main Briefs on or before Wednesday, December 3, 2025, and Reply Briefs on or before Friday, December 12, 2025.

Thus, the following Order will be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Parties shall submit Main Briefs on or before Wednesday, December 3, 2025.
2. That the Parties shall submit Reply Briefs on or before Friday, December 12, 2025.
