**MOTOR CARRIER COMPLAINT**

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission" or "PUC") is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement-Motor Carrier Division hereby represents as follows:

1. That SUSQUEHANNA VALLEY TAXI SERVICE INC, Respondent, maintains its principal place of business at 2225 Ridge Road, Northumberland, PA 17857

2. That Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience for taxi authority by this Commission on May 1, 2018, at PUC Utility Code 6418673.

3. That on October 2, 2025, PUC Enforcement Officer Elliott Miller conducted an inspection on West Third Street, Bloomsburg, Columbia County, of a 2017 Toyota Camry, bearing PA registration number TX50330, and having vehicle identification number ending in the last 4 digits 5693, driven by Stanley T. Wisowaty. The following violations were found:

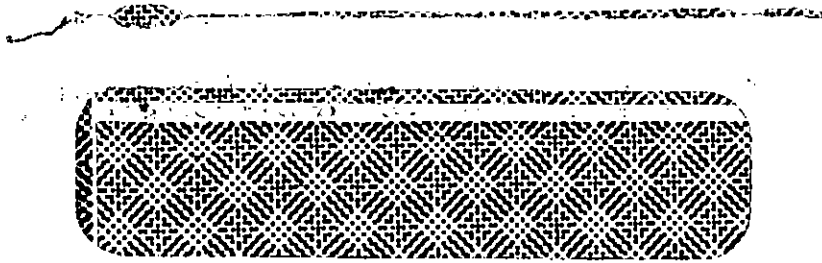
- a. Taxicab did not have a working dome light, violating 52 Pa. Code §29.314(d). The penalty for this violation is \$100.
- b. Taxicab was missing a battery securement device, violating 52 Pa. Code §29.402 (1); 67 Pa. Code §175.66 (n). The penalty for this violation is \$100.
- c. Taxicab did not have an operable rear registration lamp, violating 52 Pa. Code §29.402(1); 67 Pa. Code §175.66(k). The penalty for this violation is \$50.

**WHEREFORE**, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby requests that the Commission fine SUSQUEHANNA VALLEY TAXI SERVICE, INC the sum of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for the illegal activity described in this Complaint and order such other remedy as the Commission may deem to be appropriate.

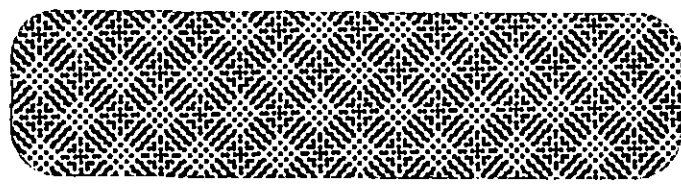
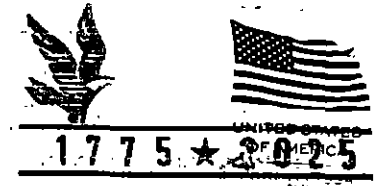
