**RESPONSES OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY TO THE
PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION’S REQUESTS FOR
SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION**

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA” or the “Company”) hereby submits the following Responses to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) Requests for Supplemental Information regarding FE PA’s Petition to Modify the Commission’s Opinion and Order entered June 13, 2024, in the above-captioned proceeding.

1. *Request for Supplemental Information: The reasons why the closing did not take place by December 31, 2024.*

Response: Closing did not take place as originally planned by December 31, 2024, because the U.S. Army, which is served by the Letterkenny Industrial Development Authority’s (“LIDA”) electric distribution system, failed to timely sign: (1) the termination of the electric services agreement with LIDA; and (2) the U.S. General Services Administration (“GSA”) Areawide Public Utility Contract. Additionally, there were delays finalizing the assignment of the easement necessary for FE PA to provide service to the U.S. Army facilities. Each of these items are prerequisites to closure of the deal as outlined in the Asset Purchase Agreement.

2. Request for Supplemental Information: A description of the upgrades that were made by the Letterkenny Industrial Development Authority (LIDA) on or after January 1, 2025.

Response: Notwithstanding the planned acquisition, FE PA currently serves as the operator of the LIDA electric distribution system pursuant to contract. As such, on or after January 1, 2025, FE PA, as LIDA's operation and maintenance ("O&M") provider, has installed new service facilities for three buildings in the area currently served by LIDA. One of those new service facilities was placed in service on March 24, 2025, while the other two were placed in service on November 1, 2025. The original costs of those facilities are \$44,814.51, \$65,882.37, and \$18,293.93, respectively. The net book values of those facilities are currently \$43,087.28, \$65,333.35, and \$18,141.48, respectively. The Company, as LIDA's O&M provider, also replaced a transformer at the Water Treatment Plant on June 18, 2025. The original cost of that project is \$20,520.40, and its net book value is \$19,964.64. Additional projects are in progress, including pole replacements and facilities for other buildings currently served by LIDA. However, the Company cannot state conclusively at this time whether any of those projects will be completed before the new closing date of December 15, 2025. LIDA transferred full payment for the costs of each of these upgrades to FE PA, including those that may not be completed by the new closing date, when LIDA presented the work orders to FE PA for processing.

3. Request for Supplemental Information: The amount that FE PA will reimburse LIDA for the upgrades that were made on or after January 1, 2025.

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
