

SECOND Request for Information

Questions for evaluation on a PUC Application require regulation compliant answers, they should be well thought out and complete, and must answer all parts of the questions asked. Please review Title 52 PA Code to ensure your answers meet that standard.

The purpose of the verified statement questions is to determine your ability to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable transportation. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses. Failure to do so is sufficient grounds to justify the denial of your application because you have failed to provide sufficient evidence of your fitness to operate. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier related proceedings is highly encouraged.

My name is Yeasin Arafat, owner of Phila One Limo & Transportation LLC.

I have more than 10 years of professional driving and transportation management experience in the Greater Philadelphia region, New Jersey, and New York.

Specific prior experience includes:

- Company: IS Luxury Limo :(as Chauffeur)

Dates: January 2021 – Present

Duties: Operate executive transportation services, manage affiliate drivers, coordinate airport and corporate transfers, maintain driver compliance, and ensure safe and timely service to clients.

- Company: Philadelphia Taxi (Transportation)

Dates: November 2015– December 2020

Duties: Daily delivery and transportation coordination, customer service, and vehicle inspection and safety compliance.

- Company: Uber

Dates: March 2014 – October 2018

Duties: Provided private chauffeur services for individuals and corporate executives between Philadelphia and New York.

Employee must have a valid PA driver's license. Must have 3 years prior livery experience, Driver History will be examined, must have no more than 1 accident/ moving violation within the last 3-5 years. If hired, a Driver History Check will be conducted annually. Prior to hire, a criminal history record will be examined. If hired, criminal histories will be pulled and examined annually. The minimum age requirement is 25 years old. Individuals aged 60 and above will require a doctor's clearance for employment. Prior employment reference check will be conducted.
