PPL Electric Utilities Corp. - Public Input Hearing Requested in Harrisburg for House Districts 103, 104, and 105 and Senate District 15

Dear Secretary Homsher,

We write to respectfully and formally request that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and the administrative law judges assigned to this rate case hold a Community Input Hearing in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, regarding the potential PPL rate increases currently proposed for PPL users.

We represent Senate District 15 and House Districts 103, 104, and 105, which cover the City of Harrisburg and the municipalities surrounding it. The Dauphin County residents we represent received a significant tax increase last year and face further increases due to the fiscal situation. To offset these tax increases, the county has already sold the Dauphin Highlands Golf Course to a data center developer. Additional data center development is also underway near Constellation Energy's Crate Clean Energy Center, formerly known as Three Mile Island. These data centers will drive up energy use in our area, further burdening residents with higher energy costs.

During the hearing, we hope to learn more about how the rate increase will be distributed between residents, businesses, and these high-user data centers. Several residents have already reached out to us seeking a time to ask questions and comment on the proposed rate increase.

Our four offices frequently work together on for residents of the greater Harrisburg area that attract strong turnout. Recently, Sen. Kim and Rep. Fleming collaborated with Veolia Water on successful public engagement events to address water quality concerns. We would again work

collaboratively to choose a site accessible to residents of our region and ensure strong attendance through our proven event marketing strategies.
