TO ALL PARTIES:

By Secretarial Letter dated October 10, 2025, the Commission issued the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge Alphonso Arnold III in the above-captioned matter. Exceptions were due within twenty days of that letter (*i.e.*, October 30, 2025). Reply Exceptions were due within ten days after the date that Exceptions were due (*i.e.*, November 10, 2025).

On October 16, 2025, the Commission received a Petition to Withdraw (Petition) the Formal Complaint originally filed on May 5, 2025, filed by DaJuan Ruff-Kelly (the Complainant) in this matter. However, our review of the filing revealed that no certificate of service or other indication that the parties of record to the case were served with the Petition as required by 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a). Therefore, we have enclosed a copy of the Petition to constitute service for purposes of 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a).

Due to the failure of the Complainant to provide service on all the parties of record to the case, and in order to avoid prejudice to any party, Philadelphia Gas Works shall have ten days from the date of issuance of this letter to file an Answer to the Petition in accordance with 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.94(a) and 5.61.
