STAY ORDER

On March 6, 2025, Oleg Rudman (Complainant or Mr. Rudman) filed a Formal Complaint (Complaint) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) against PECO Energy Company (PECO, Company, or Respondent). In the Complaint, Complainant placed checkmarks in the boxes indicating: “The utility is threatening to shut off my service or has already shut off my service,” “Incorrect charges are on my bill,” and “I would like a payment agreement.”

On April 1, 2025, Respondent filed an Answer in which it denied the material allegations of fact and conclusions of law in the Complaint. Respondent requested that the Complaint be dismissed.

By Further Telephonic Hearing Notice dated September 26, 2025, a Further Call-In Telephonic Hearing was scheduled for November 17, 2025.

On November 17, 2025, the hearing convened as scheduled. Complainant appeared *pro se*, along with his wife, Roza Kalish. Khadijah Scott, Esquire, appeared on behalf of PECO.

Prior to going on the record, both Parties advised that Complainant has a Petition for Bankruptcy pending before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania at Case No. 23-11955.

A bankruptcy petition filed under either Sections 301, 302 or 303 of the United States Bankruptcy Code will operate as a stay and bars the commencement or continuation of a judicial, administrative or other action or proceeding against the debtor, including the issuance or employment of a process, which action or proceeding was commenced prior to the start of the bankruptcy proceeding, or to recover a claim against the debtor that arose before the commencement of the bankruptcy proceeding. See 11 U.S.C.S. §362(a)(1). As a result, this matter before the Commission is stayed by operation of federal law pending resolution of Complainant's bankruptcy petition.

Complainant and Respondent are directed to file a status report with the Commission within sixty (60) days of the date of this Stay Order, and every sixty (60) days thereafter, until the bankruptcy proceeding has concluded.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the matter of Oleg Rudman v. PECO Energy Company, at Docket No. C-2025-3053918, is STAYED.

2. That Respondent and Complainant shall file status reports with the Commission at this docket, with a copy to the presiding officer and the opposing party, within sixty (60) days of the date of this Order, and every sixty (60) days thereafter, until the bankruptcy proceeding has concluded.
