Application of ANPI Business, LLC for the
Discontinuance and Partial Abandonment of
Interexchange Carrier Reseller Services to Business
Customers in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

A-2024-3050480

ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 19, 2024, ANPI Business, LLC (“ANPI” or “Company”), utility code 311006, filed an application seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience (Certificate) pursuant to Sections 1102(a)(2) and 1103 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§ 1102(a)(2) and 1103, evidencing Commission approval of the discontinuance of certain Interexchange Carrier Reseller (IXC-R) services to business customers in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

ANPI is currently certificated to provide telecommunications services throughout the Commonwealth as an IXC-R at Docket No. A-311006 and as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) in the service territories of Verizon Pennsylvania LLC, Verizon North LLC and Brightspeed of Pennsylvania LLC d/b/a Brightspeed at Docket

No. A-311006F0002.¹ The Company's Certificates of Public Convenience were issued on February 8, 2001 (IXC-R) and April 7, 2005 (CLEC).

ANPI seeks to abandon its IXC-R Certificate in part. Specifically, the Company requests approval only to discontinue provision of switchless long distance and toll-free services provided to business customers (the Services) that were originally provided by Applicant's predecessor-in-interest, Zone Telecom, Inc. Applicant is discontinuing these Services because the servers used to support the Services are at their end of their life and no longer supported by their manufacturer.²

The Company states that it plans to cease these Services to its business customers on May 31, 2025.³ The Company's proposed discontinuance of the Services will not impact or affect any residential customers.⁴ The Company included with its application a copy of the notice letter, sent to the affected customers. According to the Company, a notice letter was sent on June 6, 2024,⁵ and a reminder email to all remaining customers on August 9, 2024.⁶ On September 19, 2025, the Company states that the last two customers of the Services have moved to different carriers.⁷

ANPI states that there are no NXX codes assigned to the Company. The Company also states that there is no need to contact the appropriate municipal/city authority of the abandonment for 911 purposes since the partial abandonment does not affect local exchange service.⁸

The Company served a copy of the Application on the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Office of Small Business Advocate, and the Pennsylvania Office of the Attorney General as evidenced by the certificate of service submitted with the

Application. Also, the Company submitted the required filing fee of \$350 with the Application pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.43. In addition, the Company is current on all assessments, reports, and regulatory fees. No protests were made since the Application was filed, and no hearings were held. Further, no motions or petitions were filed in this proceeding.

Section 1103(a) of the Code provides that a Certificate “shall be granted by order of the commission, only if the [C]ommission shall find or determine that the granting of such certificate is *necessary or proper* for the service, accommodation, convenience, or safety of the public. The [C]ommission, in granting such certificate, may impose such conditions as it may deem to be just and reasonable.” 66 Pa. C.S. § 1103(a).

Upon full consideration of all matters of record pertaining to the Application and in accordance with Section 1103 of the Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1103, we find that approval of the Application would be in the public interest and the Company is approved to partially discontinue IXC-R services; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Application of ANPI Business, LLC is hereby approved.
2. That a copy of this Order be served on the Bureau of Registration and Taxpayer Management in the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue.
3. That ANPI Business, LLC, file the necessary tariff supplement to its Interexchange Carrier Reseller Tariff within 30 days of the entry of this Order.

4. That upon the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience authorizing the Partial Discontinuance or Abandonment of certain Interexchange Carrier Reseller Services to Business Customers by ANPI Business, LLC in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, this case be marked closed.
