Dear Secretary Homsher:

This corrected letter is filed by The York Water Company (“York Water” or “Company”) in lieu of Exceptions to the Recommended Decision (the “RD”) issued by Administrative Law Judge Emily A. Farren (the “ALJ”) dated November 12, 2025, in the above captioned proceeding. The Company notes that in its original letter filed November 18, 2025, a reference to Ordering Paragraph No. 9 was inadvertently included in the paragraphs below. This second letter omits that reference to avoid any confusion.

In the RD, the ALJ recommended approval of the Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement of All Issues (the “Settlement”) concerning York Water’s proposed acquisition of the wastewater assets of CMV Sewage Co. Inc. (“CMV”), the abandonment by CMV of wastewater service to the public in its service territory in Chanceford Township, York County, and approval for York Water to

begin to offer wastewater service to the public in Chanceford Township, York County, as provided in the Settlement.

This letter's purpose is to notify the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") of certain typographical errors in the Proposed Conclusions of Law, the Proposed Ordering Paragraphs, and the Joint Stipulation of Facts, which were subsequently incorporated in the RD, so that such errors can be corrected in the Final Order entered in this proceeding. Specifically:

1. The references to "water service" in Finding of Fact No. 28, Conclusion of Law No. 15, and Ordering Paragraph No. 5 should be changed to "wastewater service";
2. The references to "water distribution system" in Finding of Fact No. 37 should be changed to "wastewater collection system"; and
3. The references to "water system assets" in Ordering Paragraph No. 7 should be changed to "wastewater system assets."

Accordingly, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission correct the typographical errors noted above in the Final Order issued in this proceeding, to avoid any confusion regarding the wastewater service that will be provided by York Water if the Application is ultimately approved. Prior to submitting this letter, York Water consulted with the Office of Consumer Advocate and CMV, the other signatories to the Settlement, regarding this request. York Water is authorized to represent that the other parties have no objections to this request.


