The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Duquesne Light Company's proposed Supplement No. 96 to Tariff Electric-Pa. P.U.C. No. 25 and the supporting rate computations submitted on October 1, 2025 to become effective on December 1, 2025.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Default Service Supply (DSS) rates for the Residential & Lighting and Small Commercial & Industrial classes for the six-month period of December 1, 2025 through May 31, 2026; and for the Medium Commercial & Industrial class for the three-month period of December 1, 2025 through February 28, 2026, are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSS is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
