Application of Sandy Township for approval to alter the public crossing (DOT 148 682 Y) by the installation of a shared use pathway where State Route 4017 (Shaffer Road) crosses, at grade, the former track of Buffalo & Pittsburgh Railroad, Incorporated located in Sandy Township, Clearfield County.

To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated February 12, 2024, the Commission approved the subject application, allocation of costs, and assignment of future maintenance responsibilities at the subject crossing.

On October 2, 2025, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (Department) notified a Commission staff engineer via telephone that all work at the subject crossing had been completed. Following notification by the Department a final inspection was arranged by a Commission staff engineer and held on October 28, 2025, where it was determined that all work had been satisfactorily completed. No party present at the final inspection stated they were seeking any reimbursement for costs it incurred on the project.

Numbered Paragraph 3 of the Commission's Secretarial Letter dated February 12, 2024, directed Sandy Township to submit detailed final construction plans and signing and pavement marking plans to all parties of record for review and to the Commission for approval prior to the start of construction.

On October 29, 2025, the Department on behalf of Sandy Township, efiled the final plans required by Numbered Paragraph 3 of our Secretarial Letter dated February 12, 2024, with proof that a copy was served on all the parties of record.

We have carefully reviewed the record of this proceeding and find that all outstanding matters have been satisfied by the parties.

The Commission issues this Secretarial Letter in accordance with Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code and finds that all work has been satisfactorily completed, THEREFORE:

1. The plans provided to the Commission on October 29, 2025, entitled "SANDY TOWNSHIP DRAWINGS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF STATE ROUTE 4017 SECTION TSA IN CLEARFIELD COUNTY ALSO STATE ROUTE 4014 ALSO LOCAL ROUTE T-356 MAPLE AVE ALSO TRAIL" consisting of twenty-nine (29) sheets of final detailed construction plans are hereby approved.

2. The case be "CLOSED."

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.



If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
