To participate in the hearing,

At the above date and time, you must call into the hearing. You will not be called by the Presiding Officer.

WITNESSES. If you have any witnesses you want to have present during the hearing who are participating from a separate phone, you must provide them with the Conference and PIN numbers above.

FAILURE TO APPEAR. You must attend the hearing and present evidence on the issues raised in the pleadings. You may lose the case if you do not take part in this hearing and present evidence on the issue(s) raised. Your case may be dismissed “with prejudice” which means that you will be barred from filing another complaint raising the same claim(s) and issue(s) presented in the dismissed complaint. If you are unable to attend the hearing for any reason, you must request a continuance using the procedure described below.

CONTINUANCES. You may request a continuance of the hearing if you have a good reason. All continuances will be granted only for good cause. To request a continuation, you should submit a written request (a “motion”) at least five (5) days before the hearing. To submit a motion by phone, call the OALJ scheduling office at 717.787.1399 and ask for Christina Biggica. Your motion should include: 1) The case name, number, and hearing date; 2) The reason for the request; and 3) Whether the other party agrees (or if you do not know).

REPRESENTATION. If you are an individual, you may represent yourself or you may have an attorney represent you. All others, including a partnership, corporation, limited liability company, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania, or admitted *pro hac vice*. Only an attorney may represent someone else.

PRESENTING EXHIBITS. If you intend to present any documents or exhibits at the hearing, you must send one (1) copy to the Presiding Officer and one (1) copy each must be sent to every other party. All copies must be received at least five (5) business days before the hearing. Proposed exhibits should be properly pre-marked for identification purposes.

ACCOMODATION. Any party who needs accommodation for a disability in order to participate in the conference may request one. Please call the OALJ scheduling office at 717.787.1399 at least five (5) business days prior to your conference to submit your request.

If you require an interpreter to participate in the conference, please call the scheduling office at 717.787.1399 at least ten (10) business days prior to your conference to submit your request.

Persons with a hearing and/or speech impairment may dial 711 to use a TTY-based Telecommunications Relay Service.

FILING DOCUMENTS. ALL Parties to proceedings pending are encouraged to EITHER open and use an eFiling account through the Commission’s website at www.puc.pa.gov OR to ensure timely arrival, submit the filing by overnight delivery as explained below.

E-FILING. The Public Utility Commission offers a free e-Filing Subscription Service, which allows users to automatically receive an email notification whenever a document is added, removed, or changed on the PUC website regarding a specific case. PAPER FILING. If you do not have the capability to open and use an e-Filing account, you may file paper documents with the Secretary of the Commission. Filing of paper documents must be sent by overnight delivery to:
