BRIEFING ORDER

This matter was initiated on February 16, 2024, through the filing of a Formal Complaint by Ryan Flynn against the Pennsylvania-American Water Company, raising incorrect billing issues regarding a mobile home park that he owns.

On November 5, 2025, a telephonic evidentiary hearing was held in this matter. Near the conclusion of the hearing, the parties discussed the filing of briefs. The parties agreed to the filing of main briefs 30 days after the submission of the electronic transcript of the hearing, and to the filing of reply briefs 15 days after the filing of main briefs. Tr. 105-106. On November 24, 2025, I received a copy of the electronic transcript of the telephonic evidentiary hearing.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the parties shall file and serve **main briefs on or before December 26, 2025, and reply briefs on or before January 12, 2026**, in conformance with the Commission’s regulations at 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.501, *et seq.*

2. That the briefs must contain, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.501(a):

- i. A concise statement or counter-statement of the case.
- ii. Reference to the pages of the record or exhibits where the evidence relied upon by the filing party appears.
- iii. An argument preceded by a summary. The party with the burden of proof shall, in its main or initial brief, completely address, to the extent possible, every issue raised by the relief sought and the evidence adduced at hearing.
- iv. A conclusion with requested relief.

3. That the parties shall file the original copies of the main brief and reply brief with the Commission via eservice no later than 4:30 p.m. on the date due.

4. That any brief not filed and served on or before the date set forth above will not be accepted except by special permission.

5. That the parties are advised not to include any extra-record evidence in their briefs.

6. That a party shall not introduce evidence or argument in the reply brief that is repetitive, should have been included in the main brief or substantially varies from the party's case-in-chief.

7. That if a brief contains a citation to an unreported decision a copy of that unreported decision must be appended to the brief.

8. That if a brief contains a citation to a decision available only on LEXIS (and not through Westlaw), a copy of that decision must be appended to the brief.

9. That all briefs submitted in this proceeding are to be provided to the Presiding Officer in Microsoft Word format.

10. That extensions of the due dates above may be provided upon good cause shown.
