



**MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR A  
CONTINUANCE OF SCHEDULED HEARING**

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, Met-Ed Rate District (Respondent or Company), by and through its attorneys, Reger Rizzo & Darnall LLP, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15, respectfully requests that the Honorable Steven K. Haas (Judge Haas) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) grant its Motion for Continuance (Motion) and issue an order continuing the scheduled Call-in Telephonic Hearing for December 10, 2025 (Hearing) as the Company’s fact witness, Laurie Parker, is unavailable for the Hearing.

In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

1. On May 1, 2025, Chris Davies (Complainant) filed a Formal Complaint requesting reimbursement for damages alleged to have resulted from the termination of non-residential service in the name of Deborah L. Matthews (Customer) to 1844 Rt 739, Dingmans Ferry, PA 18328, (Service Address) under Account No. 100016375980 (Current Account).

2. On May 21, 2025, the Company filed an Answer denying the Complainant’s recitation of events and averring that the Company’s actions had been reasonable and performed

in accordance with all applicable laws, as well as the Company's Commission-approved tariff, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code (Code), Commission regulations and orders.

3. By Notice, dated September 19, 2025, an Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing was scheduled for Wednesday, December 10, 2025, before Judge Haas.

4. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 (b) states:

(b) Except as otherwise provided by statute, requests for continuance of hearings or for extension of time in which to perform an act required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time by this title or by order of the Commission or the presiding officer, shall be by motion in writing, timely filed with the Commission, stating the facts on which the application rests, except that during the course of a proceeding, the requests may be made by oral motion in the hearing before the Commission or the presiding officer. Only for good cause shown will requests for continuance be considered. The requests for a continuance should be filed at least 5 days prior to the hearing date.


5. The unavailability of the Company's fact witness, Laurie Parker, constitutes good cause consistent with Commission regulation.

6. On November 25, 2025, the office of undersigning Counsel contacted the Complainant *via* telephone to notify him of the Company's need for a continuance of the scheduled hearing, and the Complainant advised that he opposed the Company's request.

7. The Company respectfully requests the Call-in Telephonic Hearing be rescheduled for a date after December 10, 2025.

**WHEREFORE**, for good cause shown, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, Met-Ed Rate District, requests that the Honorable Steven K. Haas grant its Motion for Continuance of the scheduled December 10, 2025, Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing.
