

**MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR A CONTINUANCE OF THE SCHEDULED HEARING**

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, Met-Ed Rate District (Respondent or Company), by and through its attorneys, Reger Rizzo & Darnall LLP, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15, respectfully requests that the Honorable Alphonso Arnold III (Judge Arnold) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) grant its Motion for Continuance (Motion) and issue an order continuing the scheduled Call-in Telephonic Hearing for December 17, 2025 (Hearing) as the Company’s fact witness, Laurie Parker, is unavailable for the Hearing.

In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

1. On October 6, 2025, Kim Malek (Complainant) filed a Formal Complaint seeking, *inter alia*, to establish service in her name for residential electric service provided to 1521 Birch Street, Reading, PA, 19604 (Service Address) under Account No. 100134940558 (Pending Account).

2. On October 27, 2025, the Company filed an Answer averring that the Complainant had not met the conditions necessary to establish an account in her name.

3. By Notice, dated October 31, 2025, an Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing was scheduled for Wednesday, December 17, 2025, before Judge Arnold.

4. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 (b) states:

(b) Except as otherwise provided by statute, requests for continuance of hearings or for extension of time in which to perform an act required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time by this title or by order of the Commission or the presiding officer, shall be by motion in writing, timely filed with the Commission, stating the facts on which the application rests, except that during the course of a proceeding, the requests may be made by oral motion in the hearing before the Commission or the presiding officer. Only for good cause shown will requests for continuance be considered. The requests for a continuance should be filed at least 5 days prior to the hearing date.


5. The unavailability of the Company's fact witness, Laurie Parker, constitutes good cause consistent with Commission regulation.

6. On November 25 and again on November 26, 2025, the office of undersigning Counsel attempted unsuccessfully to reach the Complainant *via* telephone to notify her of the Company's need for a continuance of the scheduled hearing. The Complainant did not pick up on either occasion, and her voicemail box was full. At the time of this filing, the Complainant has not responded with her position on the requested continuance.

7. The Company respectfully requests the Call-in Telephonic Hearing be rescheduled for a date after December 17, 2025.

**WHEREFORE**, for good cause shown, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (Met-Ed Rate District) requests that the Honorable Alphonso Arnold III grant its Motion for Continuance of the scheduled December 17, 2025, Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing.
