Dear Attorney Beard:

By Order entered October 9, 2025, the Commission authorized Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW” or “the Company”) to file a tariff supplement incorporating the terms of the Joint Petition of Settlement and changes to its rates, rules and regulations as set forth in Exhibits 1 and 2 of the Joint Petition filed in the above docketed rate investigation. On November 24, 2025, the Company filed Supplement No. 181 to Gas Service Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 and Supplement No. 124 to Supplier Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 to become effective December 1, 2025 in compliance with the Order. The filing also included supporting schedules for PGW’s temporary DSIC increase as approved effective December 1, 2025.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, the supplements are effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
