Request for Information

1.) Question # 10 of the Application.

As an applicant for Paratransit service, you are required to demonstrate that you have a suitable number of vehicles, offices and resources available to offer safe, efficient, and reasonable service in the multiple counties you requested to operate in. Based upon your submitted information you do not appear to have suitable assets to service the scope of the requested territory. Please revise your proposal by reducing the territory (The PUC is specifically interested in the counties from which operations will originate).

Example: To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, from points in Delaware County, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

- Originating territory can be added in the future when additional resources become available.

2.) Question #4 of the Verified Statement.

Please include the plan on how you are to secure customers' sensitive physical documents.

3.) Question #5 of Verified Statement of Applicant.

Provide compliant hiring and employment policies that satisfy the requirements of 52 Pa Code with revision to the specific chapters below in case of expansion. Please review Title 52 information online, which may be accessed at www.pacode.com.

- A.) § 29.503. Age restrictions. Will drivers have to be at least a certain minimum age?

B.) § 29.505. Criminal history. How often will a record check be done and what are the disqualifications of employment?

4.) Financial Position.

- A.) The Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet) submitted with the application reflected that Yanes Transport Services LLC has \$5000 in cash assets. Based on the submitted balance sheet, the Commission determines that Yanes Transport Services LLC lacks financial fitness to gain a Certificate of Public Convenience. To show improved financial fitness you should have substantial asset amount to cover overhead costs, such as vehicle, vehicle replacement, vehicle maintenance, insurance coverage, and/or possible fines. Please provide an improved balance sheet.
- It is expected that the applicant's account is now filled and ready to commence operations with the ability to provide safe, efficient, and reliable service. Any assets which may need transferred to the applicant should happen prior to adding them to the balance sheet. Your Statement of Financial Position should consist solely of assets and debts held by the corporation, not assets and debts held or attributable to the corporation's individual members.
- B.) Please provide proof of the mentioned \$7000 steady monthly income.
- C.) You have listed "Property (buildings, land, etc.)" in the amount of \$2000. All claimed property must also include proof of ownership/control to the LLC - registrations, titles, purchase agreements, etc. Provide proof of the LLC's ownership or remove the asset from an updated balance sheet.

D.) To be clear, is the \$2,500 in liabilities due within one year, as reported on the balance sheet?

E.) Finally, to fully assist the Commission in verifying your financial fitness, please provide supporting documentation for the balance sheet. Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements (account numbers may be redacted) and notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information) all in the name of the LLC.

- The information is to be exact and should not include estimates or approximations when accurate numbers are available. Property and vehicle valuations may be approximations, but bank accounts and loan balances should be exact amounts (rounded to the nearest dollar). You are encouraged to enlist professional financial assistance if you have trouble in constructing your statement of financial position.

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses.
