Application of Lansdale Borough to construct improvements where West Main Street (SR 0063) (DOT # 592 788 P) crosses, at grade, the tracks of Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority (SEPTA) in Lansdale Borough, Montgomery County.

To Whom It May Concern:

By Commission Secretarial Letter dated January 3, 2023, we directed the alteration of the subject crossing to be completed on or before December 31, 2024.

By petition filed with the Commission on October 31, 2025, Lansdale Borough requests the Commission grant an extension of time to coordinate the subject alteration with SEPTA's new railroad gate modernization project at the same crossing.

We have carefully reviewed the record in this proceeding and will grant Lansdale Borough an extension of time until December 31, 2027.

THEREFORE:

The petition received October 31, 2025, from Lansdale Borough be and is hereby granted to the extent herein directed.

1. Paragraph Number 9 of the Secretarial Letter issued January 3, 2023, which reads as follows, to wit:

“9. All work necessary to complete this construction shall be done in a manner satisfactory to this Commission on or before December 31, 2024, and that on or before said date, Lansdale Borough report in writing to the Commission the date of actual completion of the work.”

be and is hereby modified to read as follows:

9. All work necessary to complete this construction shall be done in a manner satisfactory to this Commission on or before December 31, 2027, and that on or before said date, Landsdale Borough report in writing to the Commission the date of actual completion of the work.

2. In all respects not inconsistent with this Secretarial Letter, our Secretarial Letter entered January 3, 2023, in this proceeding remain in full force and effect.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.



If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
