Questions for evaluation on a PUC Application require regulation compliant answers, they should be well thought out and complete, and must answer all parts of the questions asked. Please review Title 52 PA Code to ensure your answers meet that standard.

- 1) The responses to questions 5(a), 5(b), 5(c), 5(d) and 5(e) of the verified statements are insufficient. Title 52 Pa. Code § 29 provides detailed requirements. **Please provide a system which incorporates code specified compliance requirements – the specific answers required can be found by googling the Title 52, Pa Code.** Each of your answers to sections of this question were insufficient:
- § 29.503. Age restrictions.
  - § 29.504. Driver history
  - § 29.505. Criminal history.

The purpose of the verified statement questions is to determine your ability to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable transportation. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses. Failure to do so is sufficient grounds to justify the denial of your application because you have failed to provide sufficient evidence of your fitness to operate. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier related proceedings is highly encouraged.

5A Hiring standards for various drivers, which require carriers to conduct criminal and driving history checks, verify driver training, and conduct background checks before and during employment. Specific rules include disqualifying drivers with more than three moving violations in three years or a major violation, requiring a valid drivers license and background checks from all states of residence.

5B Requires common and contract carriers to conduct criminal background checks on drivers, including a criminal history record from the Pennsylvania state police and a criminal history record every other state where the driver has lived in the last 12 months. These checks must be repeated every two years for each driver. Drivers cannot operate a vehicle if they have been convicted of a Felony or misdemeanor that adversely affects their suitability to provide service.

JLT reviews online training modules for topics like passenger assistance, safety, and transport, while the PASS program and NEMTAC's offerings focus on more intensive training and certifications for a range of needs, including wheelchair and stretcher transport.

5D Before hiring, a common or contract carrier may not permit a person to operate a vehicle in its authorized service until it has obtained and reviewed a driver history from the appropriate agency of every state in which that person held a motor vehicle operators license or permit during the preceding 3 years.

Following receipt of the initial driver history report, a common or contract carrier shall, at least once every 12 months from the date of the last report, obtain a driver history for each driver operating under its authority from the appropriate agency of the state in which the driver held an operators license during the time period. A copy of the driver history shall be maintained by the common or contract carrier for at least 2 years. Conduct the driving history check again one year after hiring and every second year thereafter.

A Drivers may not use alcohol, be under the influence of alcohol, or have any measured alcohol concentration or detected presence of alcohol while operating a vehicle in passenger service, and drivers are prohibited from using or being under the influence of a controlled substance, or having any detected presence of a controlled substance while operating a vehicle in passenger service.

**Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36.** Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:

I, ZOUHAIR FAKIR hereby state that the facts above set forth are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, and that I expect to be able to prove the same at a hearing held in this matter. I understand that the statements herein are made subject to the penalties of 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

The blank should be filled in with the name of the appropriate company representative, and the signature of that representative should follow the statement.

Failure to comply with this request within 10 working days from the date of this letter will result in the denial of the application.

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
