Dear Parties:

On December 4, 2025, Comcast Phone of Pennsylvania, LLC (Comcast) filed a motion for a 30-day extension to file a response to Mr. Fine's Formal Complaint. The original response was due December 4, 2025. In its motion, Comcast averred that the parties were actively seeking a non-adjudicative resolution to the case and that, in order to facilitate the pending settlement discussions, an extension was necessary. Comcast also indicated that an attempt was made to acquire Mr. Fine's consent to the extension, but a response had not yet been received at the time of filing its motion.

Comcast is granted an extension of time to file its Answer to the above captioned Formal Complaint. It should also be noted that any further requests for extension should be made prior to the date on which the pleading is due.

Comcast's Answer and any other responsive pleadings are due to be filed with the Commission by the close of business (4:30 p.m. EST) on January 5, 2026.
