



MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR A CONTINUANCE OF SCHEDULED HEARING

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, Penelec Rate District (Respondent or Company), by and through its attorneys, Reger Rizzo & Darnall LLP, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15, respectfully requests that the Honorable Emily DeVoe (Judge DeVoe) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) grant its Motion for Continuance (Motion) and issue an order continuing the scheduled Call-in Telephonic Hearing of January 6, 2026 (Hearing) as undersigning counsel has a scheduled conflict at the same date and time.

In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

1. On July 9, 2025, Kelly Melter (Complainant) filed a Formal Complaint seeking, *inter alia*, to establish service in her name to 1338 West 35th Street, PA, 17324 (Service Location) under Account No. 100163017039 (Account).

2. On July 30, 2025, the Company filed an Answer averring that the Complainant is required to pay \$457.00 towards the Account balance and 50% of the security deposit for a total of \$807.00 to establish service in her name.

3. By Notice, dated November 18, 2025, an Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing was scheduled for Tuesday, January 6, 2026, before Judge DeVoe.

4. On December 2, 2025, the Company filed a Notice of Appearance of Margaret A. Morris, Esquire as counsel on behalf of FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, Penelec Rate District.

5. The Company's new counsel has a previously scheduled conflict with the current January 6, 2026 hearing date, in a separate, unrelated matter before the Commission.

6. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 (b) states:

(b) Except as otherwise provided by statute, requests for continuance of hearings or for extension of time in which to perform an act required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time by this title or by order of the Commission or the presiding officer, shall be by motion in writing, timely filed with the Commission, stating the facts on which the application rests, except that during the course of a proceeding, the requests may be made by oral motion in the hearing before the Commission or the presiding officer. Only for good cause shown will requests for continuance be considered. The requests for a continuance should be filed at least 5 days prior to the hearing date.

7. The unavailability of the Company's new counsel constitutes good cause consistent with Commission regulation.


8. On December 5, 2025, the office of undersigning counsel attempted unsuccessfully to reach the Complainant *via* telephone to notify her of the Company's need for a continuance of the scheduled hearing. A voicemail message was left, followed by an email. At

the time of this filing, the Complainant has not responded with her position on the requested continuance.

9. The Company respectfully requests that the Call-in Telephonic Hearing be rescheduled for a date after January 6, 2026.

WHEREFORE, for good cause shown, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, Penelec Rate District, requests that the Honorable Emily DeVoe grant its Motion for Continuance of the scheduled January 6, 2026, Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing.
