

**UNOPPOSED MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY
FOR A CONTINUANCE OF SCHEDULED HEARING**

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, Met-Ed Rate District (Respondent or Company), by and through its attorneys, Reger Rizzo & Darnall LLP, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15, respectfully requests that the Honorable Barbara Shadie Nause (Judge Shadie Nause) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) grant its unopposed Motion for Continuance (Motion) and issue an order continuing the scheduled Call-in Telephonic Hearing of January 13, 2026 (Hearing) as undersigning counsel has a scheduled conflict at the same date and time.

In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

1. On October 27, 2025, Yvette Thalman (Complainant) filed a Formal Complaint averring that the Company is threatening to shut off service in her name to 353 Remington Rd, East Stroudsburg, PA, 18301, (Service Location) under Account No. 100143279154 (Account).

2. On November 14, 2025, the Company filed an Answer denying that it had active intent to terminate service at the Service Location. However, the Company is unable to provide

another waiver of the security deposit assessed to the Account due to late payments. The Company avers that at all times relevant to this proceeding, the Company's actions have been reasonable and performed in accordance with all applicable laws, as well as the Company's Commission-approved tariff, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code (Code), Commission regulations and orders.

3. By Notice, dated November 21, 2025, an Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing was scheduled for Tuesday, January 13, 2026, before Judge Shadie Nause.

4. On December 2, 2025, the Company filed a Notice of Appearance of Margaret A. Morris, Esquire as counsel on behalf of FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, Met-Ed Rate District.

5. The Company's new counsel has a previously scheduled conflict with the current January 13, 2026 hearing date, in a separate, unrelated matter before the Commission.

6. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 (b) states:

(b) Except as otherwise provided by statute, requests for continuance of hearings or for extension of time in which to perform an act required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time by this title or by order of the Commission or the presiding officer, shall be by motion in writing, timely filed with the Commission, stating the facts on which the application rests, except that during the course of a proceeding, the requests may be made by oral motion in the hearing before the Commission or the presiding officer. Only for good cause shown will requests for continuance be considered. The requests for a continuance should be filed at least 5 days prior to the hearing date.


7. The unavailability of the Company's new counsel constitutes good cause consistent with Commission regulation.

8. On December 5, 2025, the office of undersigning counsel contacted the Complainant *via* telephone to notify her of the Company's need for a continuance of the scheduled hearing, and the Complainant advised that she does not oppose the Company's request.

9. The Company respectfully requests that the Call-in Telephonic Hearing be rescheduled for a date after January 13, 2026.

WHEREFORE, for good cause shown, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, Met-Ed Rate District, requests that the Honorable Barbara Shadie Nause grant its unopposed Motion for Continuance of the scheduled January 13, 2026, Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing.
