ORDER
GRANTING RESPONDENT’S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

On October 1, 2025, Kim Malek filed a Formal Complaint against FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission seeking a payment arrangement. The Complaint was served on FE PA on October 6, 2025.

On October 27, 2025, FE PA filed an Answer to the Complaint, admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint.

On October 31, 2025, the Commission issued a Hearing Notice setting this matter for an evidentiary hearing on December 17, 2025, and assigning me as Presiding Officer.

On November 26, 2025, FE PA filed its Motion of FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company for a Continuance of the Scheduled Hearing. In its Motion, FE PA sought continuance of the evidentiary hearing due to the unavailability of its witness on the hearing date. In its Motion, FE PA indicated that it contacted Ms. Malek to ascertain her position on the continuance request but that she did not respond.

On December 1, 2025, via email, I formed the parties that Ms. Malek had until December 5, 2025, to respond to the Motion. Ms. Malek did not respond to the Motion.
