The Bureau of Audits has reviewed PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's proposed Supplement No. 404 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 and the supporting rate computations submitted on November 26, 2025 to become effective on January 1, 2026.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Storm Damage Expense Rider (SDER) rates for the twelve-month period of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026 are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The SDER is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
