Dear Judges Brady and Pell:

As counsel for Norfolk Southern, I am writing on behalf of all parties in the above-referenced matter to provide you with a status report and to request a continuance of the rescheduled Telephonic Prehearing Conference this coming Friday, December 12, 2025.

The parties continue to make progress toward a resolution of this issue. Most importantly, the parties have agreed to an emergency response procedure to address any potential false activations of the gates and lights at the subject crossings. In that regard, I am pleased to report that there have been no reported false activations since the parties' last correspondence to you on October 30, 2025, due to the interim measures taken by Norfolk Southern.

Pinpointing the exact scientific causes of the false activations, however, is a more complex task. PECO and Norfolk Southern have been conferring regarding their experts' investigations since the issuance of PECO's confidential investigation report on October 29, 2025. PECO recently requested additional information that Norfolk Southern is gathering. At the same time, Norfolk Southern is working with its expert regarding a response to PECO's expert report. Norfolk Southern projects its expert's responsive report will be available in mid to late-January.

In order to give the parties more time to study the matter and discuss a permanent resolution, we request that the Prehearing Conference be continued to early February. While there is not much more to report at this time, if your Honors should have other questions and would prefer to continue with the Prehearing Conference on Friday, the parties would certainly do so.
