ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By the application filed on August 17, 1993, Wonderview Sanitary Facilities ("Wonderview") seeks Commission approval pursuant to Section 1102(a)(1) of the Public Utility Code authorizing an amendment to its certificate of public convenience which will allow it to offer, render, furnish or supply sewerage service to additional customers in Main and Catawissa Townships, Columbia County. Wonderview submitted proofs of service and publication. A protest was filed by the Office of Consumer Advocate but was later withdrawn before the scheduled hearing date.

Wonderview is a sole proprietorship owned by Clyde Yohey. Wonderview furnishes sewage service to 127 customers in the Wonderview Residential Development in Main and Catawissa Townships, Columbia County. Wonderview furnishes sewerage service pursuant to an Order of the Public Utility Commission ("PUC") entered on March 15, 1976, granting Wonderview a certificate of public convenience at Docket A-98490. The certificate limits Wonderview's service to no more than 113 single family residences. By another Order entered on April 20, 1993 at Docket No. R-922369, PUC approved a Joint Petition for Settlement of Rate Investigation which, inter alia, required Wonderview to apply to PUC to amend its certificate of public convenience to reflect additional customer usage above the present 113 customer maximum. In accordance with the Order of April 20, 1993, Wonderview seeks to amend its certificate of public convenience to allow it to serve no more than 161 residences (total population 470) in the Wonderview Residential Development in Main and Catawissa Townships, Columbia County.

Wonderview will employ its existing sewage plant to furnish service to the additional customers. No additional capital will be required by Wonderview to provide sewerage service to the additional customers. Wonderview will not change its approved rate (\$35.65) for service in the territory covered by the application.

A copy of pertinent pages from Wonderview's Water Quality Management Permit is attached to the application (Attachment "A") as evidence of DER certification of Wonderview's plant for service to a population of 470

people. In view of the fact that DER monitors sewage service utilities regularly, we sought more information from DER on the capability of Wonderview to provide sewage service to additional customers. Information received from DER both orally and by documentation show that Wonderview has the plant capacity to provide sewage service to up to 161 residences (total population 470).

Upon full consideration of all matters of record we find the approval of the application to be proper and necessary for the service and convenience of the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application of Wonderview Sanitary Facilities is hereby approved.
2. That Wonderview Sanitary Facilities furnish sewerage service to customers in Maim and Catawissa Townships in compliance with all DER rules and regulations.
3. That Wonderview's certificate of public convenience be amended.
