- 1. The name and address of applicant are Clyde E. Yohey, R. D. 2, Bloomsburg, Columbia County, Pennsylvania.
2. The name and address of applicant's attorney are Thomas J. Evans, Esquire, 38 West Main Street, Bloomsburg, Columbia County, Pennsylvania. (17815)
3. Applicant is a Corporation under the trade name of Wonderview Water, Inc. The said trade name has been registered with the Secretary of the Commonwealth. Attached hereto is a copy of the Articles of Incorporation and marked "Exhibit A". Attached hereto is a copy of the application for Certificate of Incorporation and marked "Exhibit B".
4. The nature and location of the proposed service are to supply water for Wonderview, Inc., situate mostly in Main Township and partly in Gatawissa Township, Columbia County, Pennsylvania. Attached hereto is a map marked "Exhibit C" and a description of the location of the proposed service, marked "Exhibit D".
5. No corporation, partnership, or individual is now furnishing or has corporate or franchise rights to furnish service similar to that of the proposed public utility in the territory of the proposed public utility and no competitive conditions will be created.

8. There is appended hereto and made a part hereof a tentative opening balance sheet of the proposed public utility, marked "Exhibit F".

9. The proposed public utility will charge the following rates for service: \$40.00 per year for fire hydrant, \$7.00 per month for water excluding pave wash. In the event meters are installed at a later time, \$1.25 per 1,000 gallons of water used.

10. The initial annual revenue of the proposed public utility are estimated as follows: \$120.00 per month or \$1,440.00 per year. The expenses are as follows:



11. The proposed public utility is now operational and is furnishing some service at the present time.

12. There is nothing planned except to extend service as lots are sold to a maximum of 140 customers.

13. Approval of the application is necessary or proper for the following reasons: There is no other water supply available to the homes that were built since they depended on the Water Company for service and it is needed because at the present time there is no central sewage system and the homes are operating with septic tanks which could contaminate the wells.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays your Honorable Commission to issue a certificate of public convenience as follows: To operate a Water Company partly in Main Township and partly in Catawissa Township, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, to serve a maximum of 140 residences.

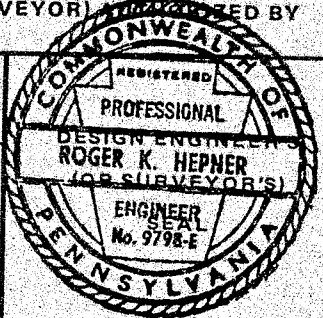

FOR 4" MINIMUM WELL SIZE - CAPACITIES IN U.S. GALLONS PER HOUR



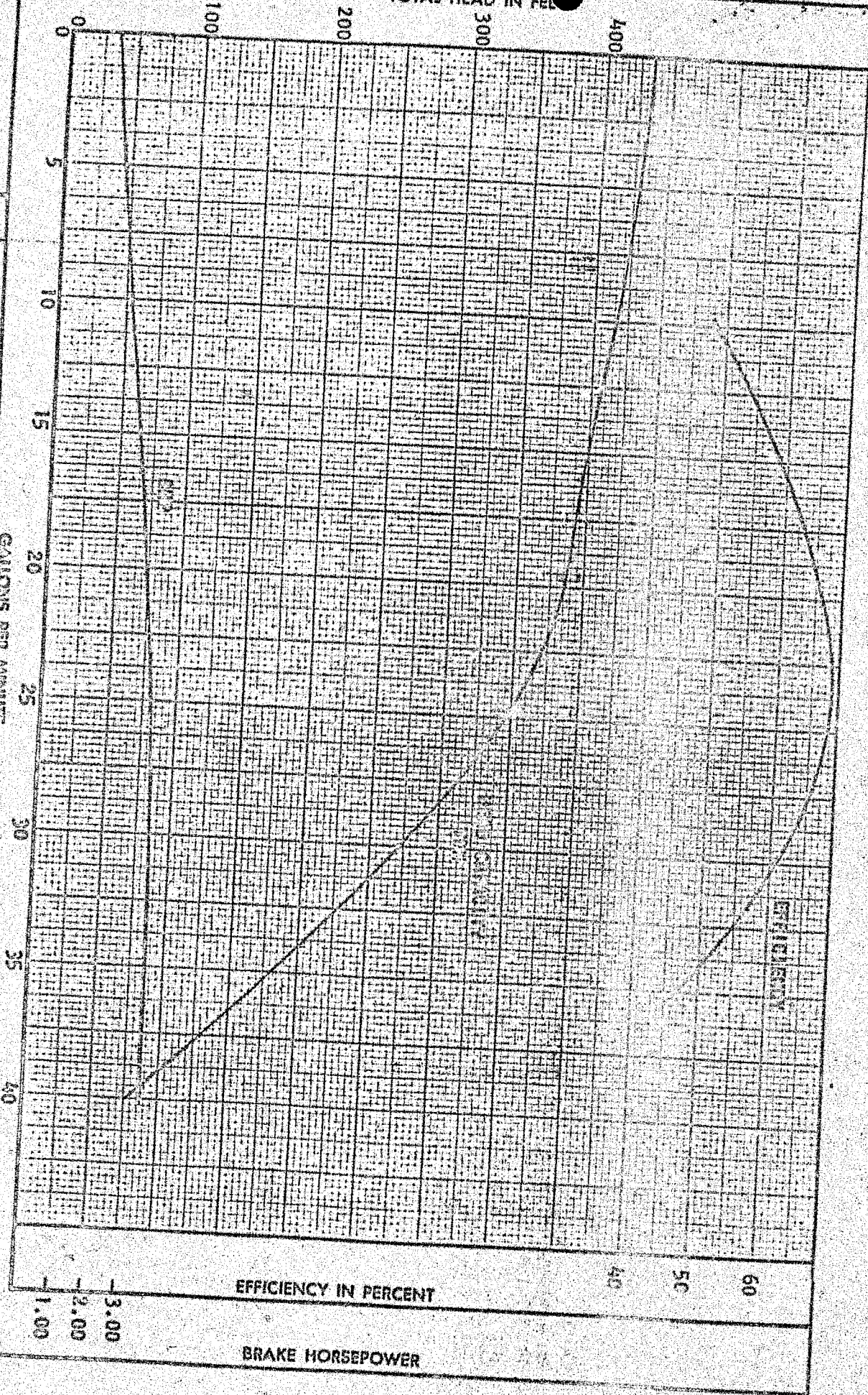
